
## What should I do if...



\*Close contact is considered to be indoors, unmasked within 3 feet of someone for a cumulative time of 15 minutes or more over a 24-hour period UNLESS in a singing or shouting setting indoors and unmasked within 6 feet for a cumulative time of 15 minutes or more over a 24-hour period applies.

\*\*Person is fully vaccinated if 2 weeks have \*\*\*Symptoms include: Fever or chills, cough, passed since receiving the 2nd dose of the shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, Pfizer or Moderna vaccine or a single dose of the fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or Johnson & Johnson vaccine. runny nose, nausea or vomiting and diarrhea



\*\*\*\*Loss of taste and smell may persist for weeks or months after recovery and need not delay the end of isolation
